









Speaking Sample - Stage 2

Stage 2 is a presentation led by the student and will take 3-5 minutes to complete

You will be asked to consider challenges and prepare a short presentation on the topic – see examples at the end of the document.

Your presentation must:

- Include an argument in-favour and an argument against
- Include a personal reflection
- Be between 3 5 minutes long
- 1. The examiner might ask you to briefly introduce the topic of your presentation and give them the code of the task, but after that they will not assist or interrupt you in any way.
- 2. The presentation must be between 3 and 5 minutes.
- 3. You can use notes, but do not read your presentation directly from a script or screen.
- 4. Please address the examiner directly.
- 5. Do not read your presentation as your speaking level cannot accurately be assessed and this will have a negative impact on your score.
- 6. Please begin your presentation by saying, 'I will now begin my presentation' and end it by saying, 'thank you for your attention'.

Which do you think is the best way to stop people from throwing trash on the ground? Discuss both options and say which you think is more suitable and why.

What are the advantages and disadvantages of using an app to track your sleep? Discuss both sides and give your opinion.

Social media use by children

A survey showed that 97% of children over 12 years old use social media. (Source: The Guardian) Do you think there should be a minimum age for using social media? Why or why not? Use what you've seen or know to help explain.
